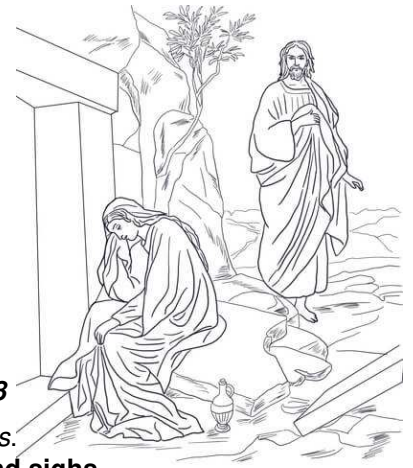




# St Edward's Church in the Parish of Roath
