



ST EDWARD'S ORGAN FUND. As many of you will be aware we were able to enjoy our organ being played by Prof Norman Doe at the end of the Mothering Sunday service. The first stage of renovation is nearing completion. There is a significant amount of additional work required to secure the future of our organ. Fund raising is continuing as we need to raise approximately £50,000 more, but we are delighted to learn this week that two charities have responded to applications, the Benefact Trust, who have awarded us £4,250 and the Pilling Trust who will donate £4,667. We are enormously grateful to the generosity of both charities and all who have donated to us. St Edward's Orchestra's concert last week also raised an amazing £650 for the Organ Fund.
