

Next Sunday is Quinquagesima (Transfiguration Sunday). The Holy Eucharist will be celebrated in St Margaret's at 8am and 9.30am, and at St Edward's at 11am, with Choral Evensong at St Edward's at 6.30pm. Eucharist readings: 2 Kings 2. 1-12; Psalm 50. 1-6; 2 Corinthians 4. 3-6; Mark 9. 2-9.

ST EDWARD'S ORGAN PROJECT. The first part of the work is now about 90% complete. We are still waiting for the delivery from Slovenia of the inverter to convert single phase to 3 phase power, which is needed for the new blower (to make it all work). We are hoping that it will arrive in time to use the organ on Good Friday for Fauré's Requiem. Now we must concentrate on raising the money for the second part!
