This is the stone reredos, designed by John Prichard, which originally graced the wall behind the high altar here when this building opened in 1870. But in the 1920s it was decided to erect our present grander altar, designed by Sir Ninian Comper, as a tribute to the three great Victorian Vicars of Roath.

The original Prichard reredos was moved at that time to our daughter church of St. Anne, which sadly is now closed for worship.

This reredos is a much acclaimed work, and fearing that it might be lost, a decision was taken by the PCC to rebuild it here after appropriate restoration by an expert in conservation, costing in all about £10,000.

Will you help us to fund the cost of its rebuilding on the wall of the nave please? It is hoped this work can be completed by Easter.
